Commissary Corner

Here's one to help clear out the vegetable garden. Easy to do on a camping trip as well

Herbed Pasta Primavera

8 oz penne pasta

8 oz baby carrots (peeled and halved lengthwise)

8 oz fresh green beans (trimmed and cut into 2 inch pieces)

3/4 cup chicken broth

1/2 cup chopped onion

2 cloves garlic, minced

1 medium zucchini or yellow summer squash (halved lengthwise and sliced 1/4 inch thick)

2 tablespoons fresh basil

1/4 teaspoon salt

Grated or finely shredded Parmesan cheese

Cracked black pepper

- 1. Cook pasta according to package directions. Drain and return pasta to hot saucepan, cover and keep warm
- 2. Meanwhile, cook and stir carrots in olive oil for 5 minutes.

Add green beans, onion, broth and garlic.

Reduce heat and simmer, uncovered, another 3 minutes.

Stir in zucchini and simmer, uncovered, another for 4-5 minutes or until vegetables are crisp tender.

Stir occasionally throughout this cooking.

3. Toss vegetable mixture, basil and salt with pasta. Sprinkle with cheese and pepper. Enjoy

This will serve about 4 so adjust amounts as needed.
